#### **Learning objectives**

Acquisition of specialist knowledge about property crime and multidisciplinary expertise (legal, criminological and statistical) in critical analysis of the criminal phenomenon and public policy.

#### **Contents**

Trends in crimes against property; findings of the international research on property and theft; criminal policies.

#### **Detailed program**

The course begins with an overview of trends in crimes against property. Then, the main findings of the international research on property and theft will be discussed, also considering the criminal policies views in this field. Finally, crimes against property provided by the Italian Criminal Code will be analyzed also through case studies. In particular crimes such as theft, robbery, fraud, extortion, kidnapping for ransom and money laundering will be detailed.
