Learning objectives

Knowledge and understanding

Provide basic knowledge on sources of administrative authority organization, the limitations on agency actions, the agencies procedures.

Applying knowledge and understanding

Develop the approaches and methodologies for the analysis of administrative law. Appropriate capacity in learning, writing and speaking, together with a general legal knowledge.

Contents

The objective of the administrative law course is to study how the activities of public authorities develop to satisfy the public interests, fulfilling their very function of service. Particular attention will be dedicated to the analysis of the problems that have arisen due to the deep transformations presently taking place in administrative law. This approach will likely lead to a new structural concept of administrative law, placing emphasis on the new school of thought which combines elements of both public and private law. Moreover, this approach will be analysed in the context of the Italian administrative justice law in order to understand the effectiveness of citizen protection when confronted with administrative power.
