Criminal Procedure

Learning objectives

The object of this class is the study of the criminal trial, as regulated by constitutional principles, international human rights law and by the criminal procedure code.

Attention will be held to the application of these rules also in the case law, in order to provide an overview of law in action, useful in particular for a future professional skills development. For this reason, the course is enriched with the study of records from a real criminal trial.

Unit B focuses on the companies' administrative liability for offences resulting from a crime (d.lgs. 8 giugno 2001 n. 231 and following updates) which can be considered as a "new frontier" of the criminal procedure.
