Learning objectives

The course aims at providing students with a deep knowledge of the key topics of economic crimes. Corporate crimes, financial crimes, and bankruptcy crimes will be analyzed. After having achieved the theoretical understanding, students may acquire tools for critically analyzing the most problematic issues and case law.

Contents

The topics of the course are: (i) general principles of liability related to economic crimes, (ii) corporate crimes, (iii) bankruptcy crimes, and (iv) market abuse.

The basic knowledge of Criminal law is mandatory.

Teaching methods

The course will be focused on the analysis both of offenses and of case law. The teaching topics will be treated by using presentations with slides. Some experts, such as lawyers, accountants, and tax police officers, will be invited to the lectures. Students are expected to be actively involved during classes, also through the discussion about case law. Moot courts will take place at the end of the course.

An updated version of the Italian Criminal Code is needed.
