Learning objectives

The course aims to increase students' awareness about some concrete activities on the field of International Cooperation, thanks to the interaction with people working on the field. For this subject, it is not provided any theoretical framework. Working groups activities will be organized with the aim to develop problem solving skills including the elaboration of data and information given by the speakers.

The course will focus on the non – governmental organizations (NGOs, Foundations, International Charities, etc.), their activities and practices in the developing countries. The approach of this course will be empirical and not theoretical. Professionals of well-known organizations will join us in the classroom to explain their job on the field to the students. Moreover, there will be a visit outside the University in a symbolic urban place of Social and International Cooperation (i.e. international refugee camps).

Lectures and research work in groups.
