Ethnolinguistics

Topics and course structure

Ethnolinguistics investigates the relationship between codified linguistic behaviors within social groups and the socio-anthropological framework in which such behaviors are manifested. Sociolinguistics studies linguistic variation in relation to the social conditions of the speakers and their linguistic communities.
