Prerequisites

No specific prerequisite required.

Teaching methods

Teaching methods include the use of lectures, films, classroom discussions. All course material (e.g., slides, readings) are made available on the e-learning website of the course, so that also non-attending students can use it.

Assessment methods

The exam includes a written test. Multiple choice and open-ended questions will be asked in 90 minutes of time. The questions are aimed at ascertaining the effective acquisition of both theoretical knowledge and the ability to connect the different forms, spheres and processes of social psychology. The answers to each question will be evaluated in terms of correctness of the answers, argumentative capacity, synthesis, ability to form links among the different areas, and the ability to critically present the phenomena.

For students who request it, an oral interview will be also made available, on all the topics of the course, which can lead to an increase or decrease of up to 3 points compared to the written exam score.
