Learning objectives



The course aims at providing the knowledge of the labour market and the tools needed for an economic analysis of human resources.

Contents

The course aims to provide the tools needed for an economic analysis of human resources, from both the theoretical and the empirical viewpoint. The programme covers the following topics: the labour market; optimal decisions regarding the types of workers to be hired and about terminating an employment relationship; and the issues of personnel recruitment and incentives policies.
