#### **Prerequisites**

#### Assessment methods

The exam includes a written test and an oral exam. The written test consists of some questions with a closed answer (with a score of 1 or zero according to the answer provided, correct or not), and two open-ended questions (with a maximum score of 3 points each). With a score of 6 (at least), you can take the oral exam.

During the course, two partial tests will be carried out, including both closed and open-ended questions. Passing both the tests, you can directly take an integrative oral exam.
