Learning objectives

The course proposes to know and understand the complexity of mental discomfort, from normality to pathology, from subjectivity to the socio-cultural context in which it is inscribed.

To develop abilities for reflection on psychological discomfort and its socio-cultural aspects, addressing clinical aspects, from diagnosis to treatment plan.

Detailed program

Mental discomfort will be exhausted in its clinical and social aspects, stressing treatment plans and role of the different subjects involved.

Prerequisites

Teaching methods

Frontal lessons; possible group works; meetings with Psychiatric Service operators.

Assessment methods

Written examination with 3 open-ended questions (duration: 1 hour) and optional oral integration.
