Learning objectives

The course aims to increase students' awareness about some concrete activities on the field of International Cooperation and of *no profit* italian organizations, thanks to the interaction with people working on the field. For this subject, it is not provided any theoretical framework. Working groups activities will be organized with the aim to develop problem solving skills including the elaboration of data and information given by the speakers.

Contents

The course will cover the topic of the International Cooperation and of the *no profit* world in Italy, with an empirical approach. During the lessons, different roles will be explained and several actors working on the field (both institutional and not) will be introduced to the students.

Detailed program

The course will cover the topic of the International Cooperation and the no profit italian organizations, with an empirical approach. During the lessons, different roles will be explained and several actors working on the field (both institutional and not) will be introduced to the students.

The course will focus on the non – governmental organizations (NGOs, Foundations, International Charities, etc.), their activities and practices in the developing countries, and on the activities in the various issues (educational, integration, wealthy) of the no profit italian organizations. The approach of this course will be empirical and not

theoretical. Professionals of well-known organizations will join us in the classroom to explain their job on the field to the students.

Moreover, there will be a visit outside the University in a symbolic urban place of Social and International Cooperation (i.e. refugee camps, jails).

Prerequisites

No prerequisites are needed.

Teaching methods

Lectures and research work in groups.

Active participation during the lessons and the working groups. Final working group.
