Aims

Students will be aware of basic dynamics of communication process, in a systemic perspective. They will acquire skills and techniques useful to effective communication and will learn communication modes functional to relationship with woman (with particular focus to accompanying woman in childbirth process).

Contents

Effective and emphatic communication. Communication skills and abilities. Management of relational dynamics

- 1_ Communication process: components and dynamics (Linear Communication, Pragmatics of Human Communication)
- 2_ Communication awareness: verbal/paraverbal/nonverbal, mental representations and preconceptions, communication walls, assertiveness.
- 3_ Structure and tecniques for the interview: punctuation of the partners' communication procedures, wording of questions, active listening
- 4_ The counselling in woman-midwife partnership and in childbirth pathway
- 5_ Inter-cultural communication
