Aims

By the end of the course students will be able to identify and collect the most useful and important data of a surgical history, to perform a medical examination of the abdomen, to identify the presence of an ascites, to correctly perform the Murphy's manoeuvre and the Giordano's sign, to correctly identify the presence of a peritoneal inflammation, the presence of an abdominal hernia or a groin hernia, to perform a correct examination of the breast and of the axillary lymph nodes, to gather data on the insufficiency of the veins of the lower limbs. Finally, students will also be able to correctly perform a medical evaluation of the cervical area, of the thyroid gland and of the regional nodes

Contents

The primary goal is to progressively achieve a good skill and autonomy in approaching the surgical patients, in collecting data on a surgical history, and in performing a complete medical examination of such patients.
