Aims

The course aims to provide the student the ability to face problems of patients affected by the most common internal medicine diseases.

The student must:

- be able to prepare an investigation plan for the diagnostic assessment,
- be able to evaluate clinical and instrumental data in a differential diagnostic way,
- prepare a therapeutic, pharmacological and non-pharmacological plan for the acute illness phase and its possible chronicity, be able to apply preventive measures.

Contents

Discussion of different clinical cases at patient bed will aim to give epidemiological, physiopathological, clinical and therapeutic knowledge related to patients affected by cardiac, endocrine-metabolic, haematological, rheumatological, pneumological, nephrological and gastroenterological pathologies, in an integrated way.

Detailed program

Discussion of clinical cases at the patient's bed, concerning cardiovascular, respiratory, endocrine-metabolic,

neurological, gastroenterological, nephrological, rheumatological diseases. Particular attention will be paid to frail elderly patients with multimobidity.

Prerequisites

Knowledge of semeiotics and clinical methodology, of physiopathology and pharmacology.

Teaching form

Practical activity and discussion of clinical cases at patient bed
