Aims

At the end of the training, students will be able to: use nursing concepts and professional ethics in clinical situations provided by the educational project and, consequently, act in relation to the responsibilities required by the educational level; plan Nursing, collaborating with teamwork and contributing to the progressive improvement of quality of care; identify nursing needs, plan, make and evaluate Nursing for people in a complex care situation, respecting ethics.

Contents

During clinical training, in a hospital, residential or social context, students will be able to experiment the contents learned during the third year of course, according to the conceptual model in use in each section. Contents are grouped into five areas:

1. professional behavior;
2. observation skills;
3. communication skills;
4. collaboration skills;
5. technical-organizational and planning skills.

In preparation for the internship the student will deepen the contents:

- planning care to the aggressive and violent patients
- airways management
- state of shock
- non-invasive ventilation devices
- aspiration of the low-airways
