Aims

At the end of the internship, students will be able to:

- Use nursing concepts and deontological principles in care situations provided by the educational project and, consequently, act according to the responsibilities required by the training level.
- Recognize and respect roles and competencies of each member of the team, establishing relationships, participating in the activities and making constructive contributions.
- Identify nursing needs/nursing diagnosis, implement and evaluate nursing to people at different stages of life, both in a hospital and in a community context, in accordance with ethical principles

Contents

During the clinical training, in both residential and health settings, students will make experience of knowledge learned in the second year of their studies (according to the conceptual model used in the academic context).

Skills can be divided into five areas: Professional behavior; Observation skills; Communication skills; Integrative/Cooperative skills; Technical and planning skills

Detailed program

In preparation for the internship the student will deepen the contents:

- care of the dead body
- somministration of drug therapy
- nursing care for the person undergoing paracentesis and thoracentesis
- management of antiblastic therapy
- management of central venous accesses
- guidelines for isolation (air, contact, droplet)
 - peritoneal dialysis
