Aims

At the end of the training, the student will be able to: Put nursing concepts and deontological principles into patient care, as planned by the educational path and act in relation to the responsibilities required by the training level.; Recognize and respect roles and competencies of each members of the teamwork, establishing relationships, participating in the activities and making his own contribution.

Contents

During the clinical training, in both residential and health settings, students will make experience of knowledge learned in the first year of their studies (according to the conceptual model used in the academic context).

Skills can be divided into five areas: Professional behavior; Observation skills; Communication skills; Integrative/Cooperative skills; Technical and planning skills

- on nursing assistance to the pediatric patient
- on cancer patient care
- on the structural analysis of a research article
- measuring vital signs
- Hygiene exercise at the bedside of the patient
