Contents

The student will be able to know the concepts related to the employment relationship and self-employment.

Detailed program

The employment relationship. The sources of discipline. The constitutional foundations. The typical features of the employment relationship. The employment relationship with the public authorities or a private employer. The main directions of labor market reform introduced by Legislative Decree 10 September 2003, n.276 and law Nov.4, 2010, 183. The discipline of the worker: the code of conduct; the disciplinary proceedings, sanctions. The means of protection of the employment relationship. The means of protection of rights. The statute of workers, the right to strike in essential public services. Right of working mothers (Legislative Decree 151 \ '01 and subsequent amendments and additions). The self-employment: Forms and methods of independent exercise of the profession.
