### Child Neuropsychiatry (Monza)

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#### Aims

The course will provide the ability to identify the pathological characteristics related to the postnatal period and to recognize the different dimension of parenting in front of the pathological pregnancy and high risk newborn.

#### Contents

The student will be also able to assist the women in case of complicated pregnancy and birth. The student will be able to recognise and treat the most frequent complications related to the puerperium.

#### Detailed program

Sensory and motor development from the fetus to the newborn: normality and pathology. Normality and neurological pathologies in the newborn. Premature infant: characteristic of the premature newborn and its development. Major and minor consequences related to prematurity. The newborn with infantile cerebral palsy.
