# **COURSE SYLLABUS**

## **Ethics and Law**

#### **Aims**

The purpose of this course is to develop an understanding of the relationship between law and ethics in the health care field.

#### **Contents**

Outline of how law, regulation and governance mechanisms deal with the organization and development of health care systems, medical practice and the guarantee and implementation of health-related rights, with particular regard to bioethical issues.

## **Detailed program**

This course aims at giving students an overview of the main concepts of health law and bioethics, such as the right to health and its protection, the physician-patient relationship, informed consent, competency, medical negligence, and so on.

It examines the role of legislation and other governance mechanisms in tackling a range of present ethical and health policy issues. Topics may include: equity and health system sustainability, bio-law themes like abortion,

assisted human reproduction, end of life decisions and other contemporary issues.

## **Prerequisites**

Being enrolled in the 1st year of the School of Medicine and Surgery. There are no other special pre-requisites to be fulfilled before sitting the examination.

### **Teaching form**

Classroom lessons.

Students are required to participate actively in lessons with the preparation of case studies and in-depth studies on specific topics. This will offer the opportunity to contribute to collective learning in class.

During the COVID-19 restrictions, the lessons will be recorded and available online, with some live events that will be planned and communicated via email or on e-learning.

## Textbook and teaching resource

Study materials will be assigned during lessons.

When possible, teaching material will be published on the moodle platform.

#### Assessment method

Students are expected to lead a class discussion (with presentations, analyses of case studies) with a small group of other students on one of the course topics. At the end of the teaching activities, students will receive an assessment of their commitment, which may be integrated with an oral exam.
