Interprofessional Education (ipe) With Students of Healthcare Degree Courses

Aims

- The student will explore the rationale for greater integration between professionals and inter-professional practice, linked to social and other drivers related to work contexts.
- The student will reflect on the characteristics and behaviours of the professional group to which he/she belongs, the key aspects of teamwork, communication, reflective practice.
- The student will understand key aspects of interprofessional collaboration.

Contents

This elective course allows students to experience a first exposure to teamwork through an "immersion" in interprofessional teams. It offers the opportunity to reflect with students from other disciplines on the integration of values, attitudes and skills for safe professional practice.

The course is based on the experience of other European Universities and the WHO guidelines (2010).
