Learning objectives

The course provides students with the general rules governing civil procedure, taking into account both the grounds and the limits which belong to the adjudication process

Contents

Civil procedure is a set of rules that govern the litigation (and the way to dispose) of a civil case.

Detailed program

Civil procedure is a set of rules that govern the litigation (and the way to dispose) of a civil case. This course introduces students to the language and to the most important issues related to the conflict resolution, including, inter alia, action that may be taken, jurisdiction over the parties, discovery, jurisdictional remedies. It provides students with an opportunity to first look at the whole Italian procedural system, as well as to examine the relationship between procedural and substantial law, developing problem solving capabilities

Prerequisites

Basic knowledge of the Italian Constitution and the Italian Civil Code, in accordance with the prerequisites as provided by the Law Department

Teaching methods

Class lessons

Assessment methods

Oral exam.
