SYLLABUS DEL CORSO

Culture, Differenze, Conflitti

Learning objectives

This course deals with the issue of cultural differences, otherness and cultural conflicts, with the aim of highlighting the symbolic and normative components of this field. The course aims to offer the conceptual tools needed to comprehend and master some of the crucial aspects of contemporary social and cultural dynamics.

Contents

This module is structured in two parts: the first, general part is devoted to cultural differences and cultural conflicts; the second part is focused on 'ethnocultural differences' and gender differences. The analysis of these specific cultural differences is intertwined with the analysis of the relationship between differences and inequalities.

Detailed program

The module is structured in two parts. In the first part, from a general point of view, attention is devoted to cultural pluralism, cultural differences and cultural conflicts. In the second part, attention is focused on two different kinds of cultural differences: ethnocultural differences and gender differences. The process of social construction of such differences will be highlighted; stereotypes and prejudices based on ethnicity and gender will be analysed and also their effects in terms of social inequalities; communicative processes and political aspects of such differences will be also taken into account.

Prerequisites

In order to master the contents and concepts proposed students need to have a basic knowledge of sociological theories and the main sociological issues (having passed the examinations for the courses Sociology I and Sociology II).

Teaching methods

Due to the Government recommendations to contain the Covid-19 pandemic, lessons will be recorded and published on the e-learning platform. A few synchronous seminars using Webex will be arranged.

Assessment methods

During the Covid-19 pandemic, exams will take place only using Webex. A public webex-link will be available at the course e-learning page.

Under safe conditions, exams will be oral, with open questions aimed at assessing the appropriate use of the concepts proposed in the course.
