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#### Learning objectives

The laboratory focuses on the fundamentals and theories of [organizational analysis](#), elements of the complex organization and its resources, through case studies.

The goal is to provide tools to:

1. organizational analysis
2. diagnosis about the organization and its criticality;
3. role analysis.

The mode is teamwork. The meetings will take place in an interactive way: the few moments of lectures will be interspersed by watching movies, commercials, photographs, discussion about the methods and techniques of organizational check-up and analysis of critical issues. Will be stimulated critical analysis of organizational tools.

The Lab will follow a multidisciplinary approach to the organizational analysis approaches All the material required to follow the course is distributed from time to time in the classroom.
