Aims

CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY - Group psychology, leadership, group dynamics. Report writing and creative reflection as metacognitive tools in group activities. Psychological and individual differences, motivation in team work. ECONOMIC AND WORKING SOCIOLOGY PROCESS – The heterogeneity as a source of difficulty/wealth in professional contexts. The diversity management as a useful tool for the management of multicultural groups.

Contents

General aim of the course: to provide psychological and socio-cultural knowledge for understanding interpersonal group dynamics and to develop team-work and group management skills.

Detailed program

CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY – (1) Group psychology in working environment: general presentation: group taxonomy, group structure; group dynamics (interaction, processes); communication (guidelines, skills, protocols); personality differences and group activities. (2) Leadership and group dynamics: leadership: definition, taxonomy; team work and team management skills; personality differences in team work and leadership. (3) Report writing and creative reflection as metacognitive tools in group activities. (4) Psychological and individual differences, motivation in team work: personality theory; empathy; motivation; emotion regulation; DBT skills useful in group activities and team work.
