Develop skills and competencies to translate the theoretical concepts encountered during the course into empirical research strategies

Contents

Collection and analysis of empirical data for social network analysis: practical exercise (group work)

The workshop is aimed at equipping students with the basic competences and knowledge to transfer the theoretical concepts covered during the course into practical research activities

The first part of the workshop is aimed at deepening the basic concepts of social network analysis

According to students' research interests, they will be provided with datasets useful to learn how to describe, analyse and represent interpersonal and interorganizational networks

Examples of existing researches will be used in order to show how social networks can be analysed and represented through specific software
