Course title

The application of Japanese language I

Topics and course structure

"The application of Japanese language I" is a course designed to help understanding the main course "Japanese language I".

Through the exercises of reading, writing, listening and speaking students are expected to consolidate their knowledge of the language which will be acquired by attending the main course.

It is designed for students who have had little or no experience in learning Japanese.

Objectives

The aim of this course is to develop four basic skills (i.e., speaking, listening, reading, and writing) in modern Japanese with an emphasis on grammatical accuracy and socially appropriate language use.

Upon successful completion of this course, students will be able to carry on basic daily conversations such as self-introduction, inquiry of time, prices, shopping and description of trips and opinions. They can also develop the ability not only to read and write simple Hiragana, Katakana and Kanji but also complex sentences.

Methodologies

Exercises of reading, writing, listening and speaking.

Due to the COVID-19 emergency lessons are partially in attendance and students will have access to recorded video lectures.

In the video lectures the students are asked to send assignments to the lecturer by email.
