- 4-3D Finite Element Method (3D FEM) introduction and specific aspects
- 5-Explicative cases studies on instable 3D slopes
- 6-Explicative cases studies on 3D geostructures
- 7-New trends in numerical modelling in geomechanics: MPM (Material Point Method) and PFEM (Particles Finite Element Methods)
