Learning objectives

To make the student acquire a knowledge of the relationship between the rules of law and the health profession, considering the specific obligations that health professionals, with particular reference to graduates in Medicine and Surgery, are imposed in multiple fields. This with particular regard to the relationship with the patient, the knowledge of ethical rules and consent, the protection of individuals in the various forms of pensions (INAIL, INPS, Civil Invalidity, Privileged Pension) and towards the Health and Judicial Authorities.

Furthermore, another purpose of the course is to provide sufficient preparation on thanatology and the fundamental aspects of injury

To know: the judicial organization of the State; elements of criminal and civil laws; the basics of the relationship between health operators, institutions and patients; elements of forensic pathology.

Life, accident and sickness private insurance
