# Palliative Care Nursing and End-of-life Care

#### **Aims**

Improve nursing knowledge about people in the end of their life. The purpose is to make nurses aware about the correct approach focused on the person and not on the sickness. This is oriented to improve the quality of the remaining life and assist the person living this peculiar period of existence.

#### **Contents**

Palliative care is a therapeutic process aimed not only at the control of symptoms, but mainly at maintaining and recovering the best possible quality of life. This can be happen by performing therapeutic actions focused on involving psychological, social and spiritual area (re: Società Italiana di Cure Palliative SICP il core curriculum dell'infermiere in cure palliative, 2013)

Nursing activity in palliative cares requires to reach a high degree of ownership in five main areas of competence: ethical, clinical, personal communication and relationship, psychosocial and team working (*Infermieristica in cure palliative di Cesarina Prandi – 2015*)

This classes provide several contents referred to the care of terminally ill people and to nursing in palliative care.

Beside testimonies of experience and real cases by professionals working in this field, presentations of tools, technicalities and methods clinically tested or developed by the research will be held.

Additional contents will be: welcoming the patient and his relatives, mourning support, communication between nurses and patient, care relationship, ethics, integration between hospital and home care, cooperation between professionals and volunteers, working in multidisciplinary teams, team work management.
