## COURSE SYLLABUS

### Introduction To Public Law - 1

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#### Learning objectives

This course is concerned with the organization and activity of the Italian Government and other public institutions, especially the European Union. The course also provides a juridical and political framework of relations between authorities and rights with specific reference to individuals and social rights.

It introduces also to the study of the legal sources and to the mechanisms of their production.

The course then focuses on constitutional changes.

#### Contents

The course aims at building basic knowledge of several legal orders: 1) the national legal order,  
2) the organization of the institutions of the local government, and  
3) the European Union legal order.

The course illustrates also the relationship between individuals and institutions – national and European Union ones – with regard to freedoms and the means of their protection.
