Learning objectives

The course is focused on the study of the contract of carriage with particular reference to the liability of the carrier, in the various different types of transport, with respect to national, international and European legislation.

Contents

The contents shall focus on the various types of transport contracts, both with reference to passengers and to goods, through the analysis of national, international and European legislation.

Detailed program

1. The contract of carriage in general - Differences with other contracts. Applicable legislation.
2. Carriage of passengers in general. The documentation of the contract.
3. Carriage of goods in general. Documentation of the contract.
4. Carriage of passengers and related baggages by road; carriage of goods by road.
5. Carriage of goods by sea; carriage of passengers by sea.
6. Carriage by air of goods and passengers, Regulation n. 261 \2004 on denied boarding, cancellation and delay.
7. Contract of transport in tourism: all inclusive packages.
