Learning objectives

The course is aimed at the acquisition of a good knowledge of territorial autonomy in the Italian legal system.

In particular, the course aims to analyze the functionality of the regional, provincial and municipal organization and the set of relations involving the different levels of government.

Contents

The course will explain the evolution of autonomistic ideas in Italy from unification to the present days, and then focus on the organization of Regions, Provinces and Municipalities.

The difference between Regions with special statute and ordinary statute and the political, regulatory, administrative and financial autonomy of the different levels of government will be analyzed.

A further aspect will then concern the relations between the State, Regions and local authorities
