Public Policies: Decision and Implementation

Learning objectives

The course presents an introduction to public policy analysis. Students should be able to analyse public problems, design a public programme, understand its decision making and the basics for evaluating its degree of success.

Contents

The first part of the course is dedicated identify and understand collective problems and policy responses, following an applied approach to public policy analysis which is nonetheless theoretically grounded. The main topics will be as follows: a) politics and policy, b) types of policies and policy tools, c) models and theories of decision making, d) policy design, e) process analysis (actors, resources, stake, interactions), f) decisional strategies, g) implementation. Theoretical classes will be complemented with case study analyses.
