Aims

GENERAL OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE: to develop skills in processes, methods and instruments for teaching-learning of nursing and midwifery discipline in theoretical and practical area. In addition, to acquire skills in processes, methods and instruments for teaching-learning of lifelong learning in medicine for nursing and midwifery professional skill development. INTERMEDIATE OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE: to identify the characteristics of the teaching-learning process addressed to the adult person, the educational-organizational strategies in fundamentals of health professions' education and of lifelong learning in medicine.

Contents

Subjects of the course are developed through the acquisition of skills in the processes, methods and tools for teaching and learning of nursing and midwifery discipline in theoretical and apprenticeship areas. The course enables student to develop skills in processes, methods and tools for teaching-learning of continuous training for the professional development of nursing and midwifery.

Detailed program

The course aims to provide students with the tools and skills necessary to understand the following contents: EDUCATIONAL PLANNING, TEACHING METHODOLOGY 1 - Elements of andragogy, the programming and the design of basic training courses and lifelong learning addressed to nurses and midwives, the critical thinking's development, the tutorial function: tutorship, mentoring, coaching, educational objectives; EDUCATIONAL MODELS, TEACHING METHODOLOGY 2 - The teaching methods: lesson' characteristics, potentials and limits, groupwork, role-playing, case method, Problem Based Learning (PBL), storytelling, Briefing-Debriefing, clinical skills laboratory and teaching assessment.

Prerequisites

Lectures, practicals and group work. Active learning methods.
