Course title

Training and Counselling in organisations: the structuralist point of view

Topics and course structure

What is “pedagogical approach” in current organizations? Training and Counselling are two of the opportunities that Structuralism can still offer to pedagogical discourse and in world of work.

Through some capital passages of the studies of Michel Foucault and others, the aim is to study the practice of “Clinica della formazione” to make possible a new radical hermeneutic knowledge.

The lessons will address some thematic issues: the relationship between pedagogy and philosophy, the present of pedagogy, its relevance to current organizations and the pedagogical professions. Basic notions of both philosophical and pedagogical issues are requested. During the course there will be both moments of review and training as well as opportunities for clinical exercise.

Objectives

The lessons mean:

- to provide knowledge about pedagogy and the philosophy of training;

- to illustrate the main models of interpretation;
- to legitimize a pedagogical point.

In addition, the students is intended to train the following skills:

- the social and cultural representations, theoretical models of yesterday's and today's of formation;
- to be able to analyze the contexts of intervention aimed in particular for adults;
- to design experiences, operational tools and pedagogical intervention styles with today's adults.

Methodologies

I will propose:

- moments of lesson;
- reading and/or commentary on significant lyrics/songs;
- watching significant movies or scenes;
- clinical exercises to analyse personal and group educational experience.

Online and offline teaching materials

I will upload to the virtual classroom: articles, short texts, images, music... in reference to the lessons of the course; all this material is useful both for those who attend and for those who can not or want not to do so, for the purpose of preparation for the oral examination.
