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#### Learning area

Linguistics

#### Learning objectives

Acquisition of the main structures of French language; study of syntax and vocabulary; introduction to French civilization.

#### Contents

French pronunciation, syntax: elements of the simple sentence; introduction to speciality language, reading and comprehension of authentic documents about business and management.

**Teaching methods**

Lessons and lab work, in French and Italian.

## **Assessment methods**

The exam is divided in two parts

- A written test consisting of: a review of the basic language skills, an assessment of the level of understanding of written French, which also implies the knowledge of some of the themes of French culture and civilization.
- An oral examination during which the student will read a text chosen by the teacher between those studied during the semester, then answer questions to assess his understanding, and summarize the main topics.

During the Covid-19 emergency the written and oral tests will be done using the [esamonline](#) platform (for the written test) and WebEx (for the oral test).
