By analysing concrete cases, developing simulations and set-ting up micro-projects, the course, conducted mainly in a laboratory and coop-erative mode, aims to provide the most immersive and participatory experience possible of a multimodal communication capable of increasingly making re-search (and not only scientific research) a shared heritage, a new horizon within which to rethink the very concept of citizenship.
