Aims

Knowledge of the clinical and organizational characteristics of General Practice / Family Medicine and its role in primary health care and in the Health Service.

Knowledge of the organization of work in Family Medicine. Evaluate the epidemiology of diseases / problems in primary health care. Observe the healthy and sick person in his living environment (family, work, socio-cultural context ...). Evaluate the doctor / patient relationship in General Practice (trust, negotiation, information, discussion ...). Observe the relationship with the specialist doctor and with other local services. Evaluate the clinical method and approach to problems in General Practice.

The module includes a 35 hours practical internship at the General Medical Practice and two classroom sessions: introduction and debriefing
