Learning objectives

Contents

The course deals with the international law of armed conflicts, a special topic of international public law. In particular, the course is focusing on the basic rules of the conduct of hostilities.

Basic rules of the conduct of hostilities; equality of warring parties; prohibition of unnecessary injuries; military objective; military necessity; principles of distinction, proportionality, precaution.
