Learning objectives

The course aims to provide students with the knowledge of the main institutions of private law, with both a theoretical and practical-applicative approach and attention to the evolutionary aspects of the law. The study will also make use of practical jurisprudential cases that will be addressed in the classroom with a dialogic method.

Contents

The course focuses on the study of the main institutions of private law.

Detailed program

Rules, principles, sources of law. Interpretation. Subjective situations and legal relationship. Fact and effect. Individuals. Legal entities. Bonds. General regulation of contracts. Contracts. Civil liability. Prescription and forfeiture. Jurisdictional protection of rights.

Prerequisites

The course of Institutions of Private Law, being placed in the first year, does not require particular prerequisites.

Teaching methods

Lectures and support through the e-learning platform.

Assessment methods

Oral exam. Interview both on the topics covered, and on the topics not covered in class and deepened on the textbook.
