Learning objectives

The course aims at providing a set of analytical methods to deal with economic and social phenomena. Students will be provided with the bases to treat simple mathematical models in economics.

Contents

Real functions of real variables.

Detailed program

Generality about functions. Domain, image, graph. Elementary functions. Monotonicity, global maxima and minima. Inverse function. Limits and related theorems. Continuity. Weierstrass, zeroes and Darboux theorems. Discontinuity points. Differential calculus. Rolle and Lagrange and Fermat theorems. De l'Hospital rule. Taylor's formula and its applications. Convexity and concavity. Two variable functions (domain, level curves, partial derivatives, stationary points and optimization)

Prerequisites

Algebra and analytic geometry at an elementary level.

Teaching methods

Assessment methods

Written exam, consisting of practical exercises and theoretical questions.
