The course covers the whole of the Italian Constitutional Law (fundamental rights and duties and public powers' organization).

Introduction. The Law and the State. The Constitution and its fundamental principles. Forms of State and Forms of Government. Brief Italian constitutional history. International Law and European Union. The Sources of the Legal System. The fundamentals rights and duties. The constitutional organization: the electoral body, the Parliament, the Government, the President of the Republic, Regional and Local Government, the Judiciary, the Constitutional Court

Lectures. Case studies.

Written pre-selection and then oral exam (on the same day).
