Aims

Acquire adequate tools for interacting with people with disabilities or social unrest

Contents

The course presents the morphology of the central and peripheral nervous system (SN) with particular reference to the sensory and motor pathways and the functioning of the main integrative centres.

With reference to the structural organization of the SN, the ways in which man explores the environment will be treated.

The most important pathologies affecting the SN will be treated considering etiology, pathophysiology, clinic and surgical intervention techniques.

The stages of development of the SN and the possible alterations of this process will be addressed in the respective modalities of clinical expression.

With reference to the typical clinical pictures of NS pathologies, the normal and undeveloped relational mechanisms of the patient will be exposed. The use of adequate tools for interacting with people with disabilities or social hardship will be promoted. The stages of personality development and the nosography used in psychiatry will also be covered.
