Aims

The course will provide a foundation in knowledge and skills necessary for 1st year nursing students to:

1. assess, collect, organize, validate and document patient's data
2. recognize the most important nursing problems and state nursing diagnoses

Contents

Initial nursing assessment, physical examination, history taking, data collection, validation and diagnostic reasoning, fundamental nursing interventions.

Schools of Lecco, Monza and Sondrio

Nursing assessment is oriented by the Human Processes Nursing Model (MAPU). Diagnosis label statement is oriented by ICNP® terminology.

School of Bergamo

Nursing assessment is oriented by Virginia Henderson's Nursing Theory (14 fundamental needs in their biophysiological, psycho-socio-cultural dimensions). Diagnosis label statement is oriented by NANDA-International®.

By way of example, some diagnostic label will be discussed (class discussion).

Fundamental Nursing Care Interventions (e.g. vital signs, assisting patient with eating and drinking, body positioning, assisting with urinal/bedpan, urinary catheterization insertion/removal, stool/urine specimen collection, therapeutic communication, cultural/spiritual assessment, ambulation of patient with tubes/equipment, cleansing enema, cold and heat application, complete/partial bathing, mouth care, perineal care, assisting patient in avoiding dangers, taking blood samples, infection control and prevention, accidental falls risk assessment and prevention, pressure ulcer: risk assessment and prevention, prevention complications from immobility, nursing care of the dying patient, use of non-sterile/sterile gloves, preparing a sterile field etc.)
