Aims

The main purpose is to allow students in Nursing, to delve into the world of nursing in penitentiary and into the world of Operating Units of Protected Medicine by acquiring theoretical knowledge, with a view to a possible future approach with the inmate patient.

This training course has three fundamental objectives:

- 1. Show the students the reality of care in penitentiary, especially the various organizational models in this field in order to be able to contribute to a change and an improvement;
- 2. Improve students' ethical approach in order to appear to the inmate patient with solid values, paying particular attention to the issues of life in prison.
- 3. Show students how important it is collaboration between nurses and prison officers: often it is not easy, but is essential to reach a common aim.
