Contents

Accidental deaths in Magnetic Resonance due to ignorance or underestimation of the risk associated to the magnetic field are rare, but possible. Relatively more frequent are damages to the magnet, the coils, the instrumentations and the health personnel, resulting by the accidental introduction of metallic objects near the magnet.

Adequate knowledge of the physical principles of Magnetic Resonance and above all the standards that health personnel –particularly Radiographers- working in Magnetic Resonance must follow, significantly reduces the risk of such events.
