Aims

The main objective of the course is to provide the basic knowledge to be able to manage the different cases one might encounter, in particular with regard to lesions of the periodontium and enamel.

Issues related to Skeletal Muscle Disorders that may arise from postural errors in daily practice will also be addressed.

DMS: musculoskeletal disorders with incorrect postures in daily practice

- White spot, Trauma according to Andreasen, Caries, Erosions, Abrasions, Abfraction, Drugs.
