Aims

The student should be able to recognize the role and the contributions of psychology to health care

Contents

Aim of the teaching is to give students the tools to understand ethical issues in healthcare, including those concerning the relationship between healthcare workers and patients and between healthcare workers and workplace

Assessment method

Written test in itinere with open questions. The questions are aimed at ascertaining the effective acquisition of both theoretical knowledge and the ability to apply them in the real context. The evaluation criteria are: the correctness of the answers, the ability to argue and synthesize.

For those students who request it, an oral interview is also provided, on all the topics of the course, which can lead to an increase or decrease of up to 3 points compared to the score of the written exam.
