Financial Markets Law

Learning objectives

The main objective of the course is to provide specific training on the forms of regulation and supervision (subjects, activity, and markets), with reference to Italian and European juridical contexts. The course will analyze also the Innovation Technology of the financial sector (FinTech), in order to make students aware of the great changes taking place in the industry.

Contents

The course aims to examine the regulation of the financial sector, with particular attention to aspects of public regulation and supervision.

The course will also try to highlight the critical aspects of the current system in the light of recent technological innovation focusing on the use of tools such as algorithms and artificial intelligence for the provision of financial services (High Frequency trading and Robo-advice); on new crypto-assets, based on blockchain and DLT; on new financing instruments for companies (equity-crowdfunding and Initial Coin Offering).

2. The principle of technological neutrality and the regulatory sandboxes.
3. Securities market supervision (role of CONSOB and ESMA)
4. The notion of security and the new categories of crypto-assets.

8. The traditional funding mechanism of enterprises: the supply of financial products to the public.
